# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 23 Required Credits
- Promotion requirements
  - 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>: 5 credits (1 credit each Lit, Math, Science)
  - 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>: 10 credits (2 credits each Lit, Math, Science)
  - 11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>: 16 credits and have met all other promotion requirements

1 common set of requirements for all students
23 total units required for all students
<b>English Language Arts</b> 4 units required for all students (Must include 9 <sup>th</sup> Lit and American Lit)
<b>Mathematics</b> 4 units required for all students
<b>Science</b> 4 units required for all students including: (Biology), (Physical Science or Physics), (Chemistry or Earth Systems or Environmental Science or an AP science course) and one additional science unit (the 4 <sup>th</sup> science unit may be used to meet both the science and elective requirements)
<b>Social Studies</b> 3 units required for all students including World History, US History, Economics and Government (Humanities is strongly encouraged for all college bound students)
½ unit of <b>Health</b> and ½ unit of <b>Personal Fitness</b>
<b>World Language and/or Career Tech (CTAE) and/or Fine Arts</b> A total of 3 units required (students planning to attend a school in the GA University System and many other private and out of state universities must take at least two units of the same world language)
4 additional elective units for all students

- Honor Card- 3.0 weighted and higher (by semester)
- Academic Letter- 4.0 for fall and spring semester \*\*EMAIL YOUR COUNSELOR IF THIS APPLIES TO YOU
- National Honor Society- 3.9 weighted and higher (invitations given out in fall- 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>)
- Service Cord- If students accumulate 200 hours of community service before graduation, they will receive a cord to wear during the graduation ceremony \*Can use hours from previous school \*Covid flexible, see counseling website for handout
