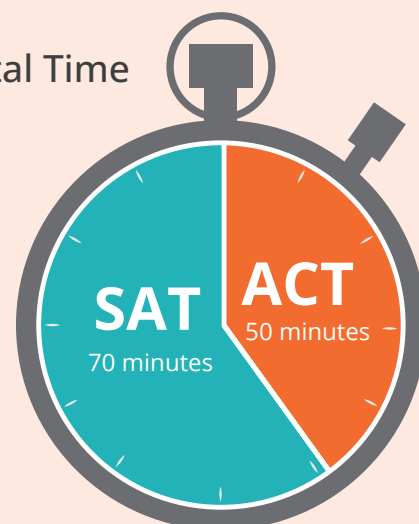

The **SAT provides** a reference of common formulas in the testing application.

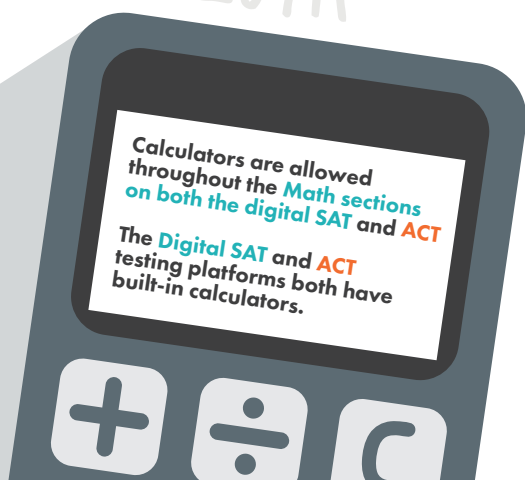
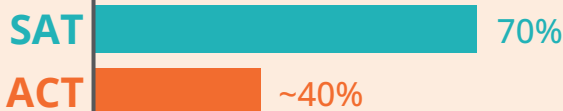
The **ACT does not provide** formulas for reference.



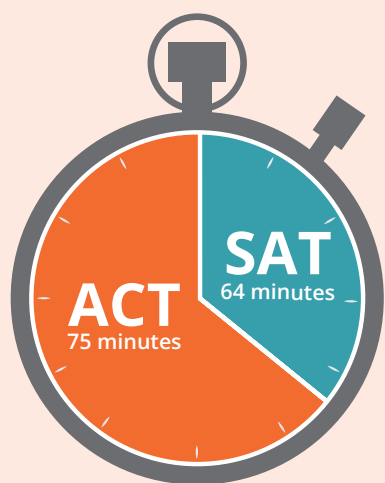
The digital SAT Math modules include 44 questions total. About 25% of these are student-produced response questions (i.e., grid-in), and the rest are multiple-choice.

Algebra Focus

The SAT has a much greater emphasis on Algebra, as well as Data Analysis questions that ask you to incorporate information from tables and charts into your calculations. In contrast, the ACT has a more evenly spread focus among Pre-Algebra, Algebra, and Geometry.

Topics Covered

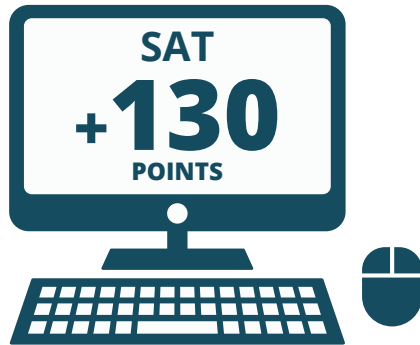
- Literature • Social Science • Poetry
- Nat. Science • History • Humanities

Distribution of topics varies. Easier adaptive modules tend to focus on literature; harder adaptive modules tend to focus on humanities and sciences.

- Prose Fiction • Humanities
- Social Science • Natural Science

ACT Reading passage topics are consistent and appear in the same order on each test.
